### Overview

Your home health agency is expected to be in compliance with the new CoPs effective January 13, 2018. There are no more delays, no grace period. You will be expected to have implemented action plans to be in compliance with Infection Control, Quality Assessment and Performance Improvement, Emergency Preparedness; and Patient Rights and other Conditions with multiple revised standards. This one-day interactive program has been totally revamped and is based on CMS' newly released "draft" Interpretive Guidelines, as well as the instructors' extensive mock survey experience and knowledge of previously published guidance to surveyors.

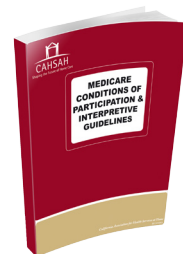
